&lt;p&gt;A gi ( 道着 ), meaning dress or clothes, is composed &#129766; of a heavy c  
otton jacket, reinforced drawstring pants, and a belt which communicates rank.&

&lt;p&gt;Some schools require the jacket and trousers &#129766; to be the same  
color, while more relaxed schools do not enforce matching top and bottom color.&

&lt;p&gt;The Brazilian jiu-jitsu gi &#129766; is often referred to as kimono by

Brazilians.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Some Jiu-Jitsu schools avoid using a gi and instead focus on no-gi jiu-

jiitsu; &#129766; 10th Planet Jiu Jitsu is an example of this.[1]&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The only colors allowed for international championships are white, blac

k or blue.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;In some jurisdictions this is relaxed to &#129766; allow any single so

lid color.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;According to article 8 of IBJJF rules,[2] a competition gi must conform

to these specifications:&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The gi &#129766; must be constructed of cotton or similar material and

be in good condition.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The material may not be excessively thick or &#129766; hard to the poi

nt where it will obstruct the opponent.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Colors may be black, white or blue, no combined colors (white &#129766;) Tj T\* BT

&lt;p&gt;The jacket is to be of sufficient length down to the thighs, sleeves mu

st reach the &#129766; wrist with arms extended in front of the body.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The sleeve should follow the official measurements according to IBJJF () Tj T\* BT /F

&lt;p&gt;Belt width must be 4 5 cm, with belt color corresponding to the practit

ioner&#39;s rank.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The &#129766; belt must be tied around the waist with a double knot, t

ight enough to secure the kimono closed.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;An extremely worn/dicoloured &#129766; belt may need to be replaced b

efore competing.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Athletes are not permitted to compete with torn kimonos, sleeves or pan

ts that &#129766; are not of proper length, or with T-shirts underneath the kim

ono (except for females).&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;A BJJ practitioner is not allowed to &#129766; paint his/her gi.&lt;/p
