Following several modifications, roulette achieved its prese nt layout and</p> <p> wheel structure about 1790, after which it rapidly gained status as the e leading game in</p> <p> the casinos and gambling houses of Europe. During the years 1836 to 1933, roulette was</p> <p> banned in France.</p> <p>Equipment The roulette table is composed of two sections, the wheel& lt;/p> <p> itself and the betting layout, better known as the roulette layout. Th ere are two</p&qt; <p> styles of roulette tables. One has a single betting layout with the roulette wheel at</p> <p&qt; one end, and the other has two layouts with the wheel in the centre . The wheel spins</p> <p> horizontally. Heading the layout design, which is printed on green baize, is a space</p> <p> containing the figure O (European style) or the figures O and OO (Amer) Tj T* BT /F
