To make a side bet, simply place chips equal to or less than the table limit on any of the available side bet spots.

Depending on the casino, there may be additional side bets available. Each side bet offers its own rules, payouts and odds so make sure to check them before making your wager.

What are the side bets in blackjack?

If you're looking for more fun and a bigger payout, side bets could be for you. Side bets are additional wagers that can be made at the start of each round and will pay out depending on the outcome of the round.

21 + 5, 3

21 + 3 is one of the most popular side bets in blackjack, allowing you

to make a separate bet on the first two cards dealt and the dealer's up card.

You are betting that these three cards will create a three-of-a-kind or a straight flush. If the combined value of your first two cards and the dealer's up card matches a certain combination, you can win a payout of 9:1 or higher.

You must place the side bet before any cards are dealt to be eligible for this bonus. Be sure to familiarise yourself with the rules before attempting this side bet.

Suited three of a kind

One of the more complex side bets in blackjack is the suited three of a kind. This bet requires you to have three cards that are all the same suit.
