If you are a German speaker and you are looking for high quality European Roulette action then you have come to the right place. Live Deutsches Roulette is a classic game of European Roulette, but the croupier runs the game in German. You will find all of the features you need, such as a Racetrack betting area, and will find yourself immersed in the action thanks to the multiple camera angles and the high definition video streams. While enjoying the game, you can chat to the croupier and your fellow players in German.

Game Flow

Live Deutsches Roulette follows the standard European Roulette rules. The game features the spinning wheel that has been divided into 37 numbered segments, and you need to bet on which segment the ball will come to rest on.

There are two betting areas, a standard one and a Racetrack, as well as various shortcuts to place different kinds of bets. You need to place your chips on the relevant segments during the betting time and then the croupier will release the ball into the wheel. Once the ball has stopped, winning bets are paid out and you can place your chips for the next round.

Bets Explained

There are a huge number of different bets in Roulette. The game has been designed to allow for great flexibility when betting. The numbers do not run sequentially around the wheel and they have been coloured red and black, other than zero, which is green. Furthermore, the betting areas have a very specific layout. Thanks to this, in addition to individual numbers you can also bet on groups of numbers. The group may be numbers that share a characteristic, such as all the red or odd numbers, or it may be a group as formed by the layout of the betting areas.

Roulette bets are divided into inside and outside bets. The inside bets are:

Straight A bet on an individual number

Street A bet on a row of three numbers on the betting area

Split A bet on two adjacent numbers
