formerly played handball professionally.[1]

Career [edit]

Malinowski started playing poker seriously in 2014. He began playing fr

eeerolls and \$ the lowest stakes offered for online cash games. Over the next

two years, he managed to become a regular at \$ mid to high stakes online cash

games playing under the alias "limitless". In 2024, he won the World

Championship of \$ Online Poker\$25K High Roller Turbo, winning\$726,000 in th

e process.[1]

While on Joey Ingram's podcast, Malinowski offered a "heads-up

challenge to anyone, \$ playing while drunk".[2] In June 2024, Malinowsk

i won the partypoker High Roller Club\$25,500 Main Event winning\$443,750 in the

process.[3]

In August \$ 2024, Malinowski won a\$842,438 pot from Michael Addamo

while playing NLHE on the poker site Natural8.[4] It became the largest \$ onl

ine pot in NLHE history beating the previous record of\$723,938 won by Di Dang a

gainst Tom Dwan in 2008.[5] The \$ record was beaten just a few days later whe

n Bosnian-born poker player Almedin Ali Imsirovic won a pot worth\$974,631 whi

le \$ playing NLHE online.[6] Approximately one week later Malinowski won anot

her pot worth\$500,146 holding 7 ♣ 2 ♣ for a wheel.[7]

In 2024, he \$ won the first place prize of\$3,690,000 at the Super H

igh Roller Bowl Europe held in North Cyprus Turkish Republic (North \$ Cyprus)

becoming No. 2 on Poland's all-time money list.[8]

As of September 2024, Malinowski's total live tournament winnings e

xceed\$4,300,000.[9]
